WELCOME TO TERM 4 2025

We hope that your teen had a meaningful and restful September holiday, and you were able to spend some quality time with him/her. As we enter the final term of 2025, we would like to provide you with key updates and information on events/programmes in Term 4 for our Sec 2 students.

A. CCA Matters

 CCA activities have stood down from Tue 26 Aug to help students to prepare for the End-of-Year Examinations. CCA activities will resume from Fri 10 Oct.

B. End-of-Year Examinations

- The End-of-Year (EOY) Examinations for Sec 2 students will take place in Weeks 2 4, Mon 22
 Sep to Mon 6 Oct. Please refer to the notification sent on Mon 18 Aug via Parents Gateway for the detailed End-of-Year Examination schedule.
- Teachers have informed students of the topics tested for their EOY Examinations and the formats
 of the papers for each subject. The details have also been put up on class notice boards as well
 as sent to students via Google Classroom.
- 4. As part of revision, practice papers will be provided to help students familiarise themselves with examination format/demand and build confidence. These practice papers may be administered during lessons or as homework. Subject teachers will instruct and guide the students accordingly.
- 5. While examinations serve as one main avenue for teachers and students to assess learning progress, they are not the be-all and end-all of education. We look forward to continuing to partner with you to nurture the joy of learning in our students, support their holistic development, and help them see assessments as opportunities to surpass themselves.

D. 3-Day Conversational Chinese/ Malay (CCM) Programme

- 7. Our Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Department will be conducting the annual Conversational Chinese/Malay (CCM) Programme. CCM is an established MOE programme that introduces Conversational Chinese or Conversational Malay to students who do not speak the language (e.g. to Malay or Indian students / to Chinese or Indian students respectively). Through CCM, students will gain a basic understanding of the respective languages, to enable them to strengthen bonds with their peers as well as operate comfortably within the region.
- 8. For students who will be signing up for the programme, it will be conducted from **Mon 27 Oct** to **Wed 29 Oct** in school, from 8.00am to 12.00pm. Further details on CCM will be given to students by their MTL teachers at a later date.

E. 2026 Secondary 3 Subject Combination Exercise

9. The schedule for the Secondary 3 Subject Combination Exercise is shown below. We would appreciate it if you could take some time to discuss with and guide your teen in making informed choices.

If they are unsure of how to calculate their overall results (e.g. if there is Paper 1 and Paper 2), they should approach their subject teachers for assistance.
Indication of Options (online)	Thu 23 Oct (8:00am) to Mon 27 Oct (5:00pm)	 The Sec 3 subject combination allocation is based on EOY exam results only. Students should make their options based on their examination performance, as that is the most up-to-date assessment of their progress. Students are to submit their options by clicking on the form link at https://linktr.ee/bowensec2. The online subject combination form will also indicate individual student's eligibility for different combinations. Report Books will be given out on Fri 24 Oct. Students should already have sufficient information before that to think carefully about their options. The school is unable to allow students to trial out subject combinations during the new school year. Students are advised to use the week leading up to the start of the Exercise on Thu 23 Oct to think about the options and discuss with parents/guardians. The online form will be closed on Mon 27 Oct, at 5:00pm sharp.

All appeals must have parent's/guardian's online endorsement. If your teen wishes to appeal, please take time to talk the matter through with him/her so he/she is clear about his/her decision-making.
Release of Appeal Results (online)	Mon 17 Nov (12:00pm)	 Students will be able to check the appeal results via the same online system used for selection of options. No further appeals will be accepted.

F. Other Matters and Overview of Activities

- 10. To minimise disruption to the curriculum, Sec 2 students will be having their medical examination in school for the 2026 MOE-OBS programme during the scheduled school HBL day on **Wed 15** Oct between 8.00am to 2.00pm. More details on the medical examination schedule, which will include your teen's class reporting and dismissal time, will be provided closer to the date.
- 11. Sec 2 students will be dismissed at 12.30pm from Thu 16 Oct to Wed 22 Oct due to the start of the GCE O-Level Written Examinations in the afternoons. For Thu 23 Oct and Fri 24 Oct (FIESTA activities), dismissal will be at 12.30pm and 12.00pm respectively.
- 12. Report Books for Sec 2 students will be issued on **Fri 24 Oct.** Parents/guardians will not generally be invited to meet Form Teachers (FTs); but if you would like to talk to the FTs, you are welcome to contact them directly. FTs will be calling or arranging for face-to-face/video conferences with parents/guardians of selected students to provide feedback on their teen's progress and development.
- 13. The year-end school holidays are scheduled from **Sat 25 Oct 2025** to **Thu 1 Jan 2026**. The last day of school will be **Fri 24 Oct**. In addition to the CCM programme for Sec 2 students, teachers may ask selected students to return to school to provide additional support on a needs basis, between the last week of October and Student Protected Time in November (see below). Students involved and their parents/guardians will be notified.
- 14. To allow our students more time and space to rest and recharge, Student Protected Time will be from **Sat 22 Nov** to **Wed 17 Dec** (both dates inclusive) during which there will not be any school activities (e.g. no CCA activities).
